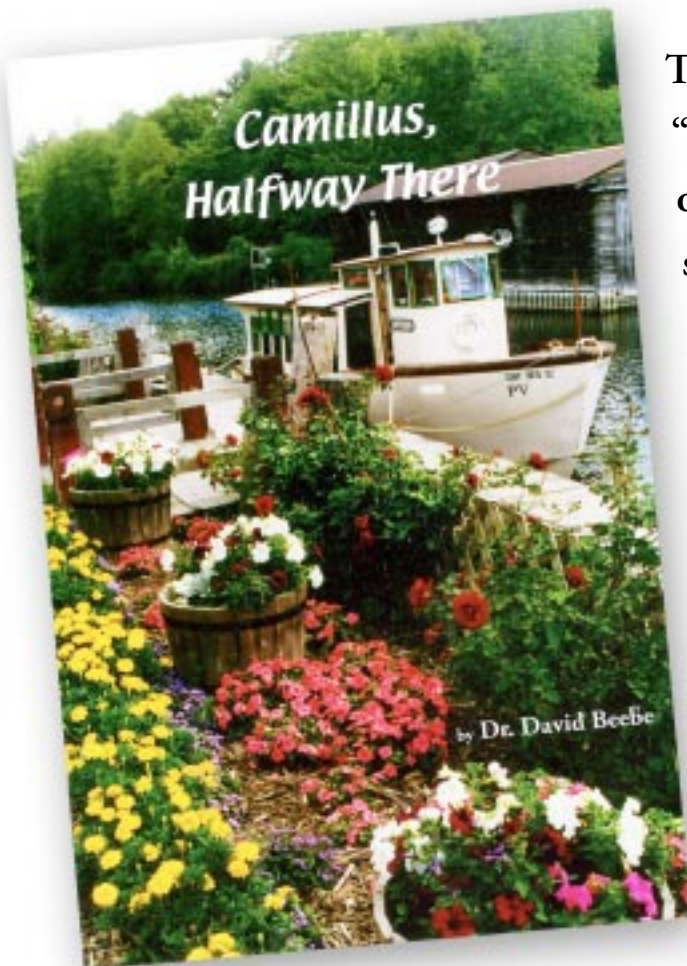


“Camillus, Halfway There”
